The fifteenth international animation festival Hiroshima has announced the Call for Entries for its 2014 competition, inviting entries from animators around the world.

Hiroshima International Animation Festival is a biennial manifestation held in Hiroshima City in August, endorsed by Association Internationale du Film d'Animation (ASIFA). It was established in 1985, as a project commemorating the 40th anniversary of the atomic bombing.

The official languages of the Festival shall be **Japanese** and **English**.

Short animated films of no more than 30 minutes, completed after *April 1, 2012*, can be submitted. Entry forms and films/videos should reach the Festival Office from *February 1* to *April 1, 2014*.

There is no entry fee.

Eligibility

All animators all over the world are welcome to enter.
