Early closing deadline: 30 June 2014. Single image entry fee: \$20. Series entry fee (from 2 to 5 images): \$25

Final closing deadline: 30 September 2014. Single image entry fee: \$25. Series entry fee (from 2 to 5 images): \$30

## Eligibility

ND Awards competition is open to all Photographers: Amateur and Professional from all over the world. Anyone over 18 years of age can enter the competition.
